- In 1900, more than 2 million wild horses roamed the West.
- Today, fewer than 32,000 remain on our public lands.
- Private cattle outnumber wild horses at least 100 to 1 on our public lands.
- Still, the round-ups continue.
- In 1971, Congress unanimously recognized wild horses as living symbols of our Nation's spirit.
- Today, a change in the law threatens thousands of our wild horses with slaughter.
- This new provision was slipped into a massive Appropriations Bill, without so much as a hearing or opportunity for review.
